- **Mon.** **Bev Denison, Local Child Evangelism Fellowship.** The Mid-State Fair is in full swing this week & Bev is in charge of getting workers to "man" the CEF booth. Pray for the workers who will speak to folks who pass-by, giving out Gospel bracelets that tell the story of salvation in the color of the beads on the bracelet. They will also share the work of Good News Clubs in the public schools.
- **Tues.** **N & J, transitioning to North Africa.** Friday they submitted papers for their visas to begin entrance to their field country. Pray the visas will be granted quickly & they will be able to make final plans to embark.
- **Wed.** Pray for our **Friends in Indonesia.** Since April of this year, 1 million (!) new cases of Covid have been recorded. Pray for God's protection over the immediate neighbors of our friends...one friend has had 143 cases of the virus in their network, including 5 leaders! Remember too, all those families reeling with the results of losing loved ones to Covid.
- **Thur.** **Danny & Christy Aanderud, Novo, UK.** Danny has been mentoring Mark for 5 years. Mark has just moved to Edinburgh, Scotland, to join a new Novo Team. Pray for Mark & this new team as they work with a church plant applying the principles of Disciple Making Movements to see God work to open Edinburgh to the Gospel.
- **Fri.** **Brad and Mary Coon, Frontier Fellowship (FF), Ipswich, MA.** The mission of FF is to point the Church to peoples & places where the Gospel has not been heard. Drawing from the wisdom of research, mission agencies, global partners and churches, they explore the intersection of people groups world religions, migrating populations, language & translations, and movements to Christ. One senior member of the staff is retiring after 27 years and 2 new team members are joining. Pray for these new leaders and the refreshment of vision in the organization during this transition time.
