- ❑ **Mon. Alban & Dori Pasho, CRU, Albania.** During April & May, Alban coordinated 8 short-term mission trips for 41 Albanian CRU staff & 43 students going to Turkey, Macedonia, Kosovo, Montenegro, Bosnia, Germany, Belgium & Spain. Pray that God uses these short-term trips to make long-term impact on the lives of those who participated.
- ❑ **Tues. Jo Shetler, Wycliffe, NC.** Pray for the attendees of the *Culture meets Scripture* workshop Jo has been co-facilitating in S. Asia. Pray as the folks go home to address changing long held tribal/church traditions to more scriptural precepts. Pray for these leaders to be courageous & as they bring folks to a place of scriptural obedience.
- ❑ **Wed. Nicole Kyker, Athletes' InterVarsity, Cal Poly.** The wrestling team Bible study at Cal Poly is working thru the book of Matthew with much excitement. Recently, after finishing Chapter 9, the group wanted to extend the study an hour longer to read & discuss Chapter 10! Almost ½ of the team is involved in the study somehow. Pray for the wisdom of the leader in facilitating the study.
- ❑ **Thur. Becca Ashton, CRU, International Christian School of Budapest.** Becca is the Recruiting Coordinator at ICSB, recruiting teachers to come overseas to teach Christian & ex-pat students. She also helps with hospitality events & programs as well as volunteering with student musical productions. Pray for Becca as she continues to minister to students & teachers at ICSB.
- ❑ **Fri. D and K.** "According to the Joshua Project, there are 3.14 Billion people out of the reach of the Gospel, but less than 1% of Christian resources are directed at reaching them. Another study found there are 4.19 Million full-time Christian workers, but 95% of them are working in the Christian or reached world. Pray God will raise up workers with a passion for reaching the unreached to make His Name known among the nations."

Brad & Mary Coon, Frontier Fellowship, Ipswich, MA.** Tomorrow, May 28th, is Pentecost, when Christians celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the early Church & the beginning of the Gospel movement in the world. It is also an International Day of Prayer for unreached people groups including Buddhist, Hindu, & Muslim peoples. Pray for the unreached & for our missionaries who work to bring the Gospel to these people.
